2. The house also recommended to increase Rs.50/- extra remuneration of Trainers and staffs during camp period.
3. Sri Atanu Sabyasachi Nayak, Hon'ble Minister & President Odisha State Bharat Scouts & Guides declared a multi proposed Open Air Auditorium will be sponsored by Higher Education Department.

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4. Members of the Council agreed to use ground floor of Scout Bhawan for different programmes, Camps and meeting of other sister organizations.
 5. It was proposed and agreed that, a Regional Training Center will function at Govt H/S ,Kutra Sundargarh for Western Odisha Districts.
 6. Sri Bhabani Prasad Mishra, State Treasure is appointed as Editor of the Scout Guide Patrika.and Sri Mihir Ranjan Pattnaik, Joint State Secretary as Printer & Publisher .
 7. Dr. Biswajit Ghose, DCC, puri is appointed as one of the State Commissioner.
 8. Dr. Biswajit Ghose, DEO, Puri and Smt Namita Pattnaik suggested maintenance renovation work should be done every year at State Headquarters, Bhubaneswar and at S.T.C, Barunei. Members were of opinion that, number of Construction & maintenance which were discussed in the Executive & Council are still pending, So those works should be attended as early as possible.
 9. The house authorized the State Chief Commissioner to consider the remuneration of Temporary staff's.
 10. The State Chief Commissioner informed and requested all District Education Officer and District Physical Education Officers to activate District OYMS portal in their District,

In query and after clear explanation of OYMS (Online Youth Management System) by the SOC (G) Smt Anamika Das. Many members and education officers raised questions like following:-

- a) What is the benefit of Students in such registration.
- b) All Students of Odisha is not having Email id,
- c) All most all Scouts/ Guides teachers now days are subject teachers. They do not have time to give details of Students and so the District Headquarters could not submit even the full list of Schools for I.R.F.
- d) When Government Organization like NSS, NCC, & Red Cross do not require such registration, Then why OSBSG.
- e) Registration procedure in all above organization is very simple. Then why so complicated in Scouting (All District Education Officer & District Physical Education Officers (District Secretaries) are also in charge of NCC & Red Cross.

The Chairman deferred this request of State Chief Commissioner to next Council enquiring the necessity of this System.

After initiation of a Rover Leader, number of District Secretaries raised the voice that, where our students are attending free camps or events in Odisha, but attending any programme or camp at National level one has to pay in thousands, not free like past reimbursement of travelling expenses and accommodation.
