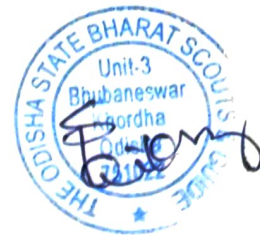

- c) Financial assistance may be extended for the Dist. Scout & Guide Bhawan.
- d) Block or Zonal wise activities may be organized in consultation with DCC, District Secretary, DCs and other senior trainers.

- e) Uniforms, Service materials & financial assistance may be extended to Colleges/Units those are doing remarkable activities.

1. While discussing the Audit report, Hon'ble President asked the council members regarding the accuracy and method of prevailing system of accounting and audit in Odisha State Bharat Scouts & Guides. In this regards the members expressed their satisfaction and no defect has been pointed in the audit report or by any member.
2. The members expressed their gratitude to President for his kind generosity by granting financial support for construction of new gallery at SHQ Campus.

4. Accordingly the letter will be sent.
5. Participation of Malkangiri Dist. in the State Council after a long gap was highly appreciated by the members. The State Chief Commissioner assured them for upliftment of Scouts and Guide activities in the District all sorts of financial assistance.
6. Smt. Subhashree Nanda, IAS, Special Secy., School Mass Education and State Commissioner has assured the house to provide all sorts of assistance from Department of School & Mass Education for all around development of Scout Guide activities.
7. In Course of discussion the State Chief Commissioner expressed concern, regarding recently development of one organization **Rashtriya Scouts & Guides** had been advertising for registration Scouts & Guides unit in every school. In this regards members should not be mislead by this organization since no affiliation or recognition given by either National Headquarters or World Scout Guide Originations. Mrs. Nanda was requested to take action on the letter written by the Chief Commissioner for not to honour the letter of Rashtriya Scouts & Guides. She was also requested to discuss the matter with Principal Secretary to increase the grant in aid as districts are demanding more financial help.

8. Members expressed their concern regarding electoral College and procedure of election prescribed by National Rule following (democratic right of member). All members unanimously demanded to follow the old By laws in future.
9. Sri T. Prasad Rao Dora Vice-President appealed the standing MLAs' as well as Vice-President of OSBSG to extend MLA Lad for improvement of Scouts & Guides activities. He also requested all members to come forward and join hands to strengthen scouting at all level.
10. Dr. Minati Behera, Vice-President suggested to include Yoga, Spiritual session during all events which has a important role in building students a disciplined citizen.
11. President during his presidential address thanked all DEOs & District Secretaries and all members for the efforts putting for the visibility of Scouting.
