## Agenda – 9

The Council carefully considered and accepted all following proposals submitted by different Committees which was discussed & recommended in the **146th State Executive Committee Meeting held on 12.5.2026.**

### A) Youth Committee Meeting (Virtually on 04.05.2026)

- 1) Camp Registration fees may be extended to those Government College/ Mahavidyalaya units attending National /International activities if fund permits.
- 2) More Rovers and Rangers should be involved in "Yuba Aapad Mitra" Scheme Training above the age of 18 years old.

### B) State Finance Committee (05.05.2026, 2.30 pm).

- I) It was proposed to complete renovation work of Hostels, Coloring work of Administrative building and installation of solar panel at State Headquarters.
- II) Repairing and coloring work of STC, Barunei Boundary Wall.
- III) A committee was formed under the chairmanship of Sri Ashok Kumar Rath, State Commissioner to discuss with the authority of ST & SC Department regarding GIA and renewal of SSD School in the movement. The Committee will also meet School & Mass Education Department regarding enhancement of GIA.
- IV) Account Section shall submit the profit/loss statement of equipment on quarterly basis.
- V) G.I racks for main store and floor repairing of main store.
- VI) Tin sheet Cover at kitchen of State Headquarters.
- VII) Construction of residential hall for Guides at STC, Barunei.
- VIII) Faver tile may be fixed at Basanta Soudha parking area.

### C) Programme & Training Committee (07.05.2026, Virtually, 2.30 pm).

- I) An equipment sale counter is to be started at STC, Barunei for smooth availability of material to the nearby districts.
- II) Rover Ranger Units will be opened in all Upgraded Higher Secondary Education Schools. The Joint SOC and Joint Secretary should take necessary action.
- III) Financial assistance may be extended to Golden Arrow participants.

### D) 146 State Executive Committee Meeting held on- 12.05.2026.

1. Election to the various posts and the calendar of election of State Council were declared, Sri Sarat Chandra Paikray, State Secretary was appointed as returning officer and Sri Bhabani Prasad Mishra appointed as asst. returning officers for the State Council Election -2026.
2. Sri Santosh Parida, Mali is confirmed as "Equipment Sale Assistant" along with his parental job w.e.f dt.1.7.2026.





3. Sri Chandan Kumar Dash, ASOC(S) is promoted as "Assistant State Secretary "w.e.f dt.01.7.2026.
4. Sri Santosh Deo ASOC(S) who was under probation as Joint SOC(S) is confirmed w.e.f dt. 01.7.2026.
5. Sri Anil Kumar Mohanty & Sri Abinash Gadanayak, have been kept as ASOC(Rovers) & (Scouts) on probation in accordance with the Odisha State Bharat Scouts & Guides Recruitment & Conditions of Service Rule-2012 w.e.f 01.7.2026.
6. 15 years old ambassador car Vide No- OR 02 BB 5242 shall be disposed of as per the verbal instruction of RTO. Vice President Sri Manoranjan Mohanty instructed the procedure must be as per RTO.

**E) Trust Board Meeting ( 10.6.2026).**

1. It was resolved that, the monthly finance assistance of retired employees has been increased as follows.  
Sri Bhagyadhar Behera , Sri Tusharkanti Acharya, Sri Mukti Krishna Choudhury enhanced by Rs,1000.00 each and class IV employees Sri Surendra Sarangi & Sri Subash Chandra Deo by Rs.500.00 w.e.f 01.07.2026.
2. The Trust Board unanimously resolved to re appoint Justice Manoranjan Mohanty as a Trustee member for further one term in accordance with the provision of the trust.
3. As per request of all office staff to life trustee, Smt Anamika Das, Joint State Secretary has been nominated as one of the Trustee for representing employees and beneficiaries.
4. Sri Abhimanyu Biswal, A.A.O asked to produce all movable and immovable asset list including patta vide khata of State Headquarters for trust records.

**Agenda – 10 ] (Other Maters).**

- a) Hon'ble Vice President Sri T. Prasad Rao Dora, pointed out a message of Sri Jagadis Mohanty regarding the rent out of Scout Bhawan Building to Kar Vision Eye Hospital. In this context Sri Ambika Prasad Dash, LT and Sri Ashok Kumar Mohapatra, DC, Kataka and many members raised the question regarding the status of Sri Jagadis Mohanty and under which capacity he is raising question as he is not a member of Odisha State Bharat Scouts and Guides.

On reply Sri Dora explained that as he is a Silver Elephant Awardee which is the highest honour of Bharat Scouts and Guides, the matter may be discussed.

The house unanimously told members have no grievances regarding the subject and this has been already discussed in the 95<sup>th</sup> State Council as per the instruction of President a Committee verified the agreement thoroughly and found correct.

- b) The question raised by Dr. Namita Pattanaik regarding rent out of Kar Vision Eye Hospital. State Chief Commissioner have conveyed the house that 6 parties had applied to take Scout

Bhawan on rent. In this regard a committee was formed to critically analyse the pros and cons of all parties regardless the financial viability and suggested to allow Kar Vision Eye Hospital on rent for a monthly rent of Rs.10 lakhs and a security deposit of Rs.50 lakhs for a duration period of 9 years.

However this matter has been deliberated in the last Council meeting.

- c) Dr. Namita Pattnaik, ASC(G), Sri Ashok Kumar Mohapatra, DC(S) Kataka & Sri Akshya Kumar Hota, DC(S) Bhadrak asked why the election is deferred mentioning Odisha State Bharat Scouts Guides is registered under society Act then why this agenda is deferred. Vice President Sri Manoranjan Mohanty assured the house to complete as soon as possible.
- d) Sri Bhagirathi Swain, Dist. Secy. Ganjam informed the house that the present financial assistance provided to districts for organizing Camporee is insufficient. it was suggested to have training course zonal wise to avoid unnecessary travelling expenses.
- e) Smt Monalisha Das, Ranger Leader raised and suggested Odisha State Bharat Scouts and Guides follow Bye Laws and discipline. She said as members coming from far to place their points, Office Bearers residing at Bhubaneswar should not raise same questions in all committee meetings.
- f) Sri Ambika Prasad Das, DC(S) & Sri Bhagirathi Swain, Dist Secy Ganjam said the election is a matter of State Council and suggested to deferred the Office bearers Election to next State Council and accordingly permission may be accorded from National Headquarters, many members supported to this proposal. Incase no nomination is there for the post of President, ex-officio President as per Rule No- 11 (I).
- g) Sri Prakash Rath, ASC(S) expressed his gratitude towards the house and regarding the unpleasant message of Sri Jagadish Mohanty. He requested all Council members to be loyal to the noble organization and urged the members to work together under one roof for the betterment of the Organization.
- h) Sri Ambika Prasad Das, DC(S), BBSR, Sri Ashok Kumar Mohapatra, DC(S) Kataka and Sri Bhagirathi Swain, Dist Secy, Ganjam, Sri Bhagirathi Mallick, Dist Secy, Mayurbhanj and Smt Monalisha Das, Ranger Leader expressed their displeased and wanted to know who is Sri Jagadish Chandra Mohanty and with what authority has written complains on Administrative matters of Odisha State Bharat Scouts & Guides.
- i) Sri Achal Pradhan, ASC(S) appreciated the activities of Odisha State Bharat Scouts and Guides. He appraised the house that the Govt. Housing Department. is now renting old house buildings at a very nominal rate. He requested that this department may be communicated to allot an old building at Baripada to run the Scout Guide activities there. However maintenance cost shall be borne by the Dist. Association.
- j) Smt Ashalata Dash, ASC(G), Smt Ahimsa Priyadarshini Senapati, LT (G), Smt Monalisha Das, RL, S.B Science College, Kanisi Ganjam, Sri Ashok Kumar Mohapatra, DC(S) Kataka, Sri Ambika Das, DC(S) BBSR, Sri Pitabas Panda, DC(S) Kendrapada & Sri Ramesh

Chandra Panda, DC(S) Puri Strongly proposed that the membership or Warrant of all undisciplined members be terminated or withdrawn strictly accordance provision of the National Headquarters Rule no-13, State Headquarters Rule No-6 (.II) ,S.O.T (8-b) and urged all members to be loyal to the organization ..

- k) Smt Ahimsa Priyadarshini Senapati, LT(G) requested members not to discuss matters repeatedly and those who are members of Executive Committee again raising questions on the matters already placed during Executive Committee is only wastage of time. She requested the Chair to avoid this .
- l) Sri Bhagirathi Mallick, Dist. Secy, Mayurbhanj requested to organize SARC (Scout Activities Review Committee) in each district. So that Headmasters of each school can be motivated and aware of the motto of Scouting and Guiding.

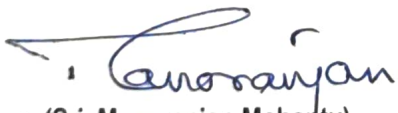
#### Agenda -11 .
